We, Falcon International Company s.a.l., hereby certify that Conapro s.a.l. had launched in 1993 two sea lines 12-inch (ASA 150) & 8-inch (ASA 300) of length 1700 meters each for Falcon Terminal in Tripoli - Lebanon,- Petrostore- and had participated in the construction of two tank farms comprising 6 storage cone roof tanks each equipped with :

- An ultra float internal floating cover
- Two low point drains
- An automatic level gauge
- Two earthing points
- One top cooling mushroom deluge nozzle
- Two ANGUS foam top pouring sets

Tanks receive from sea manifold and supply 14 loading arms each equipped with a Smith meter, through 8 transfer pumps

Tanks capacities varie from 4500 CBM TO 12000 CBM.

CONAPRO s.a.l has operated since 1993 till June 2006 Falcon Terminal Petrostore- and was in charge of inspection, maintenance and surveying tasks in the storage tanks, gas free, cleaning and desludging the tanks every 2 years & loading facilities. We, Falcon Lubes s.a.r.l., hereby certify that CONAPRO S.A.L. had launched in 1993 two sea lines 12-inch (ASA 150) & 8-inch (ASA 300) of 1700 meters each for Falcon Terminal in Tripoli – Lebanon, and had participated in the installation of the Multi-Buoy Mooring system designed to discharge tankers up to 35,000 tons DWT at water depth of 9 meters. The Falcon MBM consisted of PLEMs, non-return valves, 4 mooring buoys with quick release mooring hooks, stockless anchors with stabilizers, chains  $\varnothing$  62 mm, flexible hoses, navigational aid lights, etc.

CONAPRO has also operated between 1993 and June 2006 Falcon Terminal and was in charge of inspection, maintenance and surveying tasks in the storage tanks & loading facilities.
